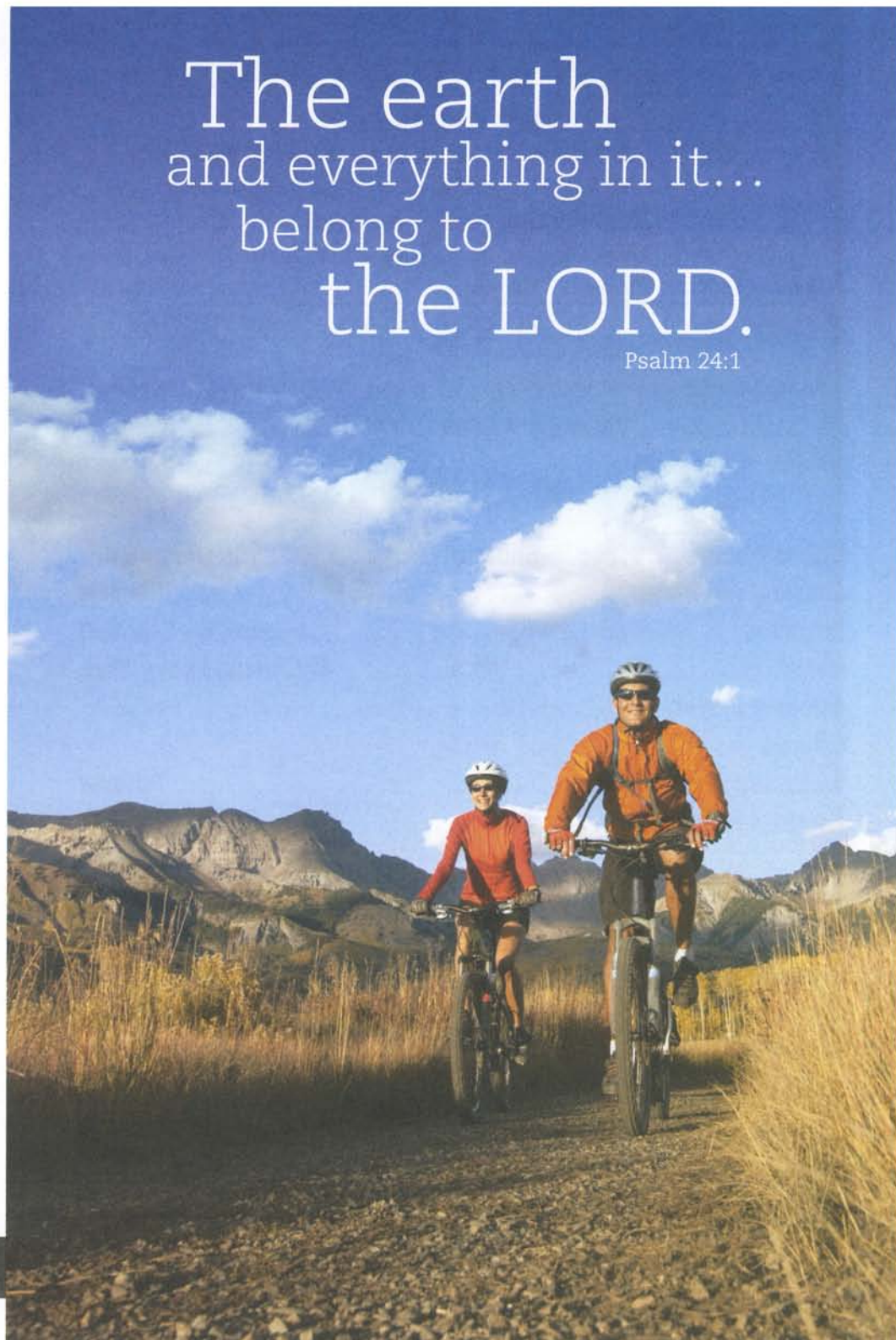

USHERS are needed. If you feel lead to serve in this ministry, please sign up in the FLC foyer for the service time and the Sunday of the month that you would be available to usher.

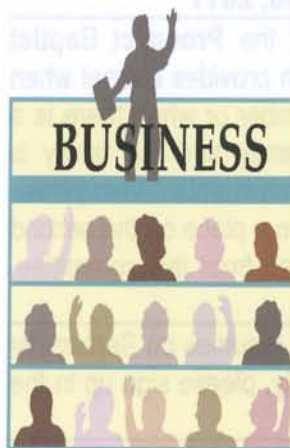
