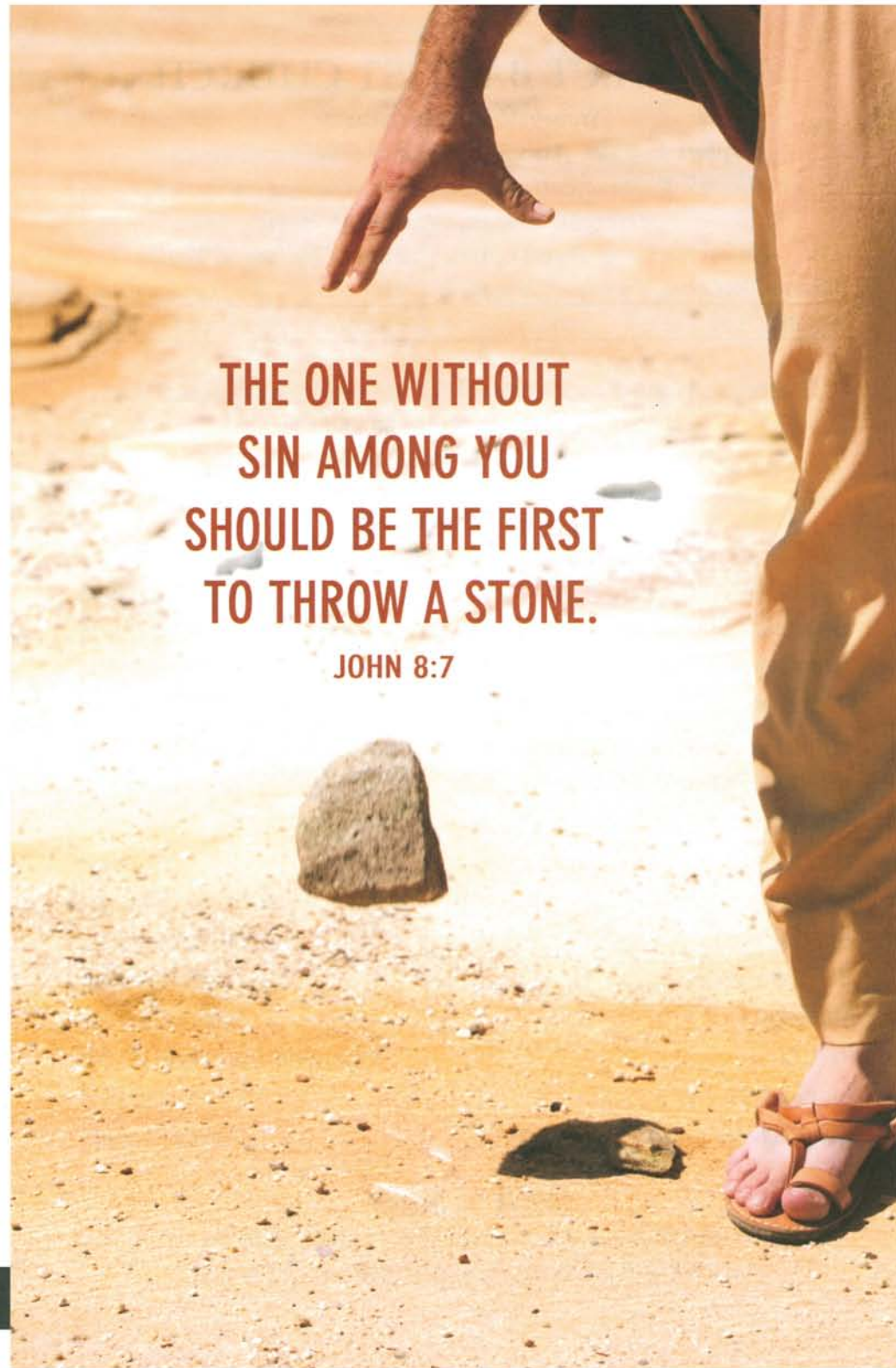

TAKE NOTE!

The Prospect Baptist Church Cemetery Trustees and Deacons agree to **change** Rule #3 of the Prospect Baptist Church Cemetery Rules and Procedures to read as follows: "No fee will be required for use of the cemetery by eligible Prospect Baptist Church members. Ineligible members and non-members of said church, who have reserved burial plots, shall pay a \$500.00 fee per grave site to the Cemetery Trust Fund **or Cemetery Up-Keep Fund** as requested by the donor. These monies will be deposited into the Cemetery Trust Fund to accrue interest at the present rate and such interest shall be used for maintenance of the cemetery or deposited into the Cemetery Up-Keep Fund to allow principal and interest in the Cemetery Up-Keep Fund to be used for cemetery maintenance.

Building and Grounds and the Deacons recommend that we purchase eight (8) portable 13 feet expandable dividers for approximately \$10,000.00 and 200 pew chairs that will stack for approximately \$8,500.00 to go into the old sanctuary. That will allow us to create four new Sunday school rooms that will hold between 25 to 30 members in each room. We will be able to move the dividers and continue to use the old sanctuary for children's church, youth ministry and funerals. We also recommend that the old pews be donated to Trinity Baptist Church in Fort Mill, SC who is moving into their own building and the pews can continue to be used for the purpose they were originally purchased. **(Please keep for reference for the Business Meeting)**
